HOW DO STUDENTS DEMONSTRATE COLLEGE, CAREER, OR MILITARY READINESS?

ANY ONE OF THESE:

- ✓ **SAT/ACT/TSIA/College Prep:** Meet Texas Success Initiative (TSI) criteria in ELA/Reading and Mathematics
- ✓ **AP/IB:** Meet criteria on Advanced Placement (AP)/International Baccalaureate (IB) examination
- ✓ **Dual:** Earn dual course credits
- ✓ **Enlist:** Enlist in the U.S. Armed Forces
- ✓ **Industry Cert:** Earn an industry-based certification
- ✓ **Associate's:** Earn an associate degree.
- ✓ **IEP:** Graduate with completed Individualized Education Program (IEP) and workforce readiness
- ✓ **CTE:** CTE coherent sequence coursework aligned with industry-based certifications
- ✓ **OnRamps:** Complete an OnRamps dual enrollment course
- ✓ **Advanced:** Graduate as a special education student from an advanced degree plan
- ✓ **Level I/II Cert:** Earn a Level I or Level II certificate

HOW IS THE CCMR COMPONENT SCORE CALCULATED FOR EACH DOMAIN?

HOW DOES CCMR IMPACT ACCOUNTABILITY?

For school districts and high schools, CCMR outcomes heavily impact the School Achievement, School Progress Part B, and Closing the Gaps domains.

DOMAIN	WEIGHT
School Achievement	40%
School Progress Part A: Academic Growth	0%
School Progress Part B: Relative Performance	50%
Closing the Gaps	30%

WHAT IS A TSI SCORE?

ACT	• 23 composite with minimum of 19 in English and Math
SAT	• EBRW 480, Math 530
TSIA	• Reading 351, Math 350

HOW DO STUDENTS QUALIFY AS CCMR FOR THE OUTCOMES BONUS?

ANY ONE OF THESE:

<p>COLLEGE</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • TSI score AND • Enroll in college or earn associate degree before graduation
<p>CAREER</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • TSI score AND • Receive an industry-based certification/Level I or Level II certification
<p>MILITARY</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ASVAB passing score AND • Enlisted

HOW DOES EXAM REIMBURSEMENT WORK?

- ✓ One reimbursement per high school student for SAT/ACT/TSIA
- ✓ One reimbursement per high school student for industry-based certification, if student passes the exam

HOW IS THE OUTCOMES BONUS CALCULATED?

Your district receives a bonus for each CCMR student above and beyond the thresholds (predicted below, will be formalized January 2020).

GROUP	THRESHOLD	BONUS
Economically Disadvantaged	9%	\$5,000
Non-Economically Disadvantaged	20%	\$3,000

Additionally, each CCMR student enrolled in special education earns your district a \$2,000 bonus.

WHEN WILL FUNDING BE RECEIVED?

In April 2020, monthly funding will be updated to include CCMR outcomes bonus based on 2017-18 graduate data.

WHAT CAN THE FUNDING BE SPENT ON?

55% must be spent on improving CCMR for grades 8-12. Allowed/suggested use of funds include:

- **Support for Student Preparation**
ACT/SAT prep, dual credit, AP, and IB
- **Support for Teacher Preparation**
Preparation, professional development, and training on ACT/SAT, dual credit, AP, and IB
- **Support for College and Career Advising**
Preparation, professional development, and training for counselors on FAFSA, college entrance requirements, career awareness and exploration, and work-based learning
- **Support for establishing and/or maintaining College and Career Readiness School Models**
